## JEAN-BAPTISTE JESSIAUME

*Grands Vins de Bourgogne*

## SAINT-ROMAIN SOUS LE CHÂTEAU

- ◆ **APELLATION:** At the foot of a high cliff, Saint-Romain occupies an elevated position in the Côte de Beaune. It is one of the earliest sanctuaries of the Celtic and Gallo-Roman vines in Burgundy. This vineyard is positioned on the slope, taking advantage of its softness and excellent soils. With this marl and limestone combination, the presence of clay is perfect for Chardonnay, which represents 65% of the plantation. The vineyards have a south/southeast and north/northeast exposure with a rough altitude of between 280 and 400 metres.
- ◆ **GRAPE VARIETY:** 100 % Chardonnay
- ◆ **SURFACE:** 0,71 hectares
- ◆ **SOIL:** Clay-limestone
- ◆ **VINIFICATION:** 100% manually harvested, upon arrival at the winery the grapes are directly pressed without crushing. After a light settling the musts are directly placed into barrels. Matured for 12 months, 100% in 350L barrels.
- ◆ **TASTING:** Coloured with golden reflections, its nose has sweet, floral and fresh almond aromas. It combines freshness with tenseness and spicy notes on the palate.
- ◆ **AGING POTENTIAL:** 7 years
- ◆ **SERVING TEMPERATURE:** 13° C
- ◆ **FOOD AND WINE PAIRING:** To be associated with shellfish, cheese or fish.
